The steep slope of these south facing vines and warm growing season are ideal for Cabernet Sauvignon (clone 08) grapes. The low yields and hand harvesting further reflect Ron Bitner’s winegrowing philosophy and result in this lavish expression of the beautiful and unique terroir of the Snake River Valley.

Well-balanced with aromas of violet and blueberry and a ripe palate of blackberry, boysenberry, and currant flavors that linger easily on a rich, velvety finish.
